What is a PAC?

A PAC is short for a Political Action Committee. Interest groups use PACs to build and maintain relationships with elected officials. One of ARM's key roles is fostering strong relationships with policymakers so our industry has a seat at the table when important decisions are being made in Lansing. PAC donations do not guarantee specific legislative outcomes, but they help ensure automotive recyclers are not overlooked during the legislative process.

How is ARM involved in this?

ARM has its own PAC, which is used to support elected officials who support the automotive recycling industry.

Why should I give to ARM's PAC?

We are stronger together. A single \$100 contribution does not go far in politics today, but if every member donates \$100 to ARM's PAC, the automotive recycling industry gains a powerful collective voice. By contributing to certain candidates, ARM's PAC can signal to legislators that our industry deserves support. When lawmakers vote on issues that affect us, we want them to understand how their decisions impact automotive recyclers. Finally, if we do not engage, others will—and they may provide misleading information about our industry that can be difficult to correct.
